Sparkler safety: Consider your child's age and maturity level, including their ability and willingness to follow rules, before allowing them to use sparklers. If using sparklers, teach children how to hold them below the point where they will burn down and to put the sparkler in a wa-

ter bucket after use. Check the area for rocks, toys or other objects to prevent children from tripping when it's dark. The space should also be far from trees, homes, and fire hazards. Make sure children are at least six feet apart when using sparklers. Make sure children know to hold

the sparkler away from their face. Use only one sparkler at a time. Ensure children wear shoes to prevent burns if they accidentally step on a used sparkler. **First aid tips for burns:** Be prepared to use first aid. For a minor

burn, place a towel soaked in cool water over the area for about five minutes. Then cover with a clean bandage and give your child acetaminophen to reduce pain and swelling. For a major burn, or if the burn involves eyes, take the child to the emergency room promptly.
