Around 300 people attended the Fight for Chandler Wright Benefit last Saturday at the Greensburg Community Center. Wright is a senior at Green County High School who is awaiting a kidney transplant. The benefit was held to offset the cost of travel and other expenses as Wright attends numerous doctors appointments. The benefit featured

live entertainment, a silent auction, a raffle, T-shirt sales, and Grand Slam BBQ. The organizing committee said that the money raised and the generosity of the community went "beyond their greatest expectations." Committee members included: Erin Frew, Karla Deaton, Rita Matney, John Hancock, Courtney Hancock, Sarah Hancock, and Melony Slinker. They also wanted to thank Jay and Buffy Scantland

for providing BBQ for the event and for Buffy's suggestions and help along the way. Marcus Edwards was one special guest who attended the event. Edwards had been on home dialysis, 5 times a week, for many years when he made a poster at a major sporting event that said, "My name is Marcus. I need a kidney." As a result of this poster, he received a transplant from a living donor October 18, 2021. Wright's moth-

er, Sandy Borders, reached out to Edwards after hearing his story. Edwards has been instrumental in keeping Chandler's family encouraged and helping spread the word. Wright's family is still praying for a successful transplant as soon as possible and encourage everyone who would consider being a living donor to be tested. Even if you are not a match to Chandler, you may be just what another family has been praying for.
