Enjoy free crafts, kids train ride, face painting, vendors, and of course... delicious food! Come for the food and stay for the fun!

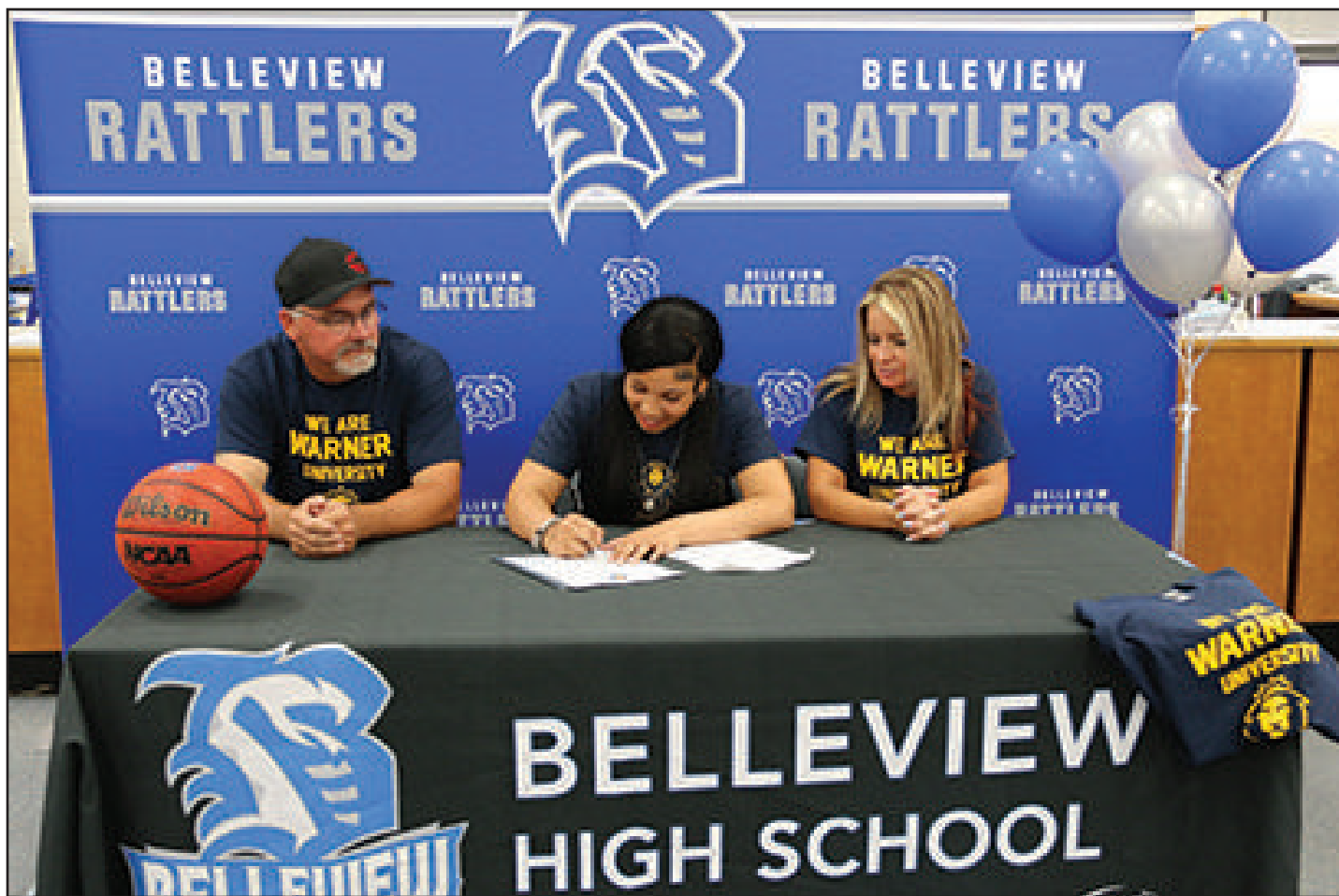

Outstanding Band Program At Lake Weir

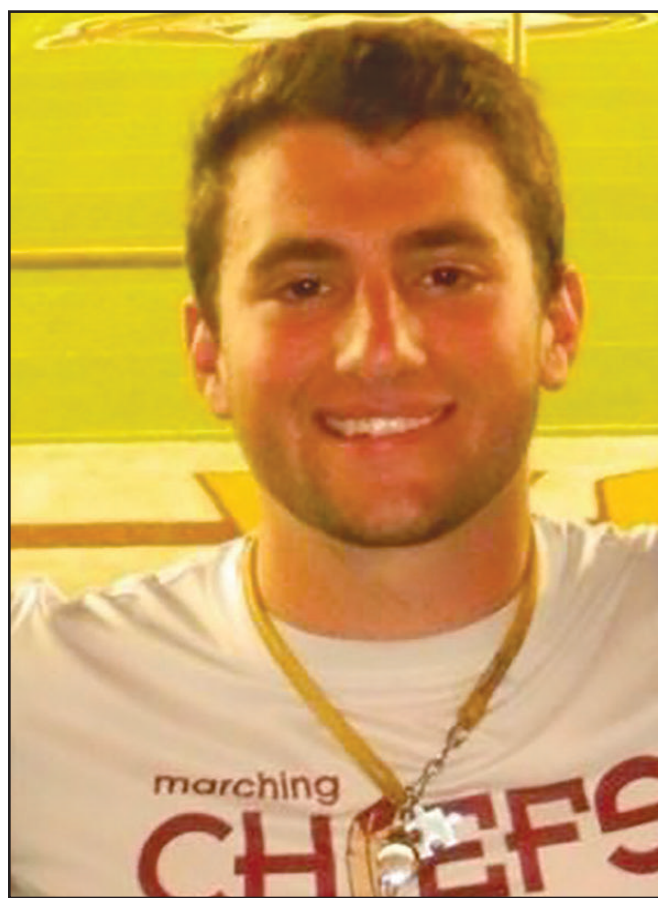

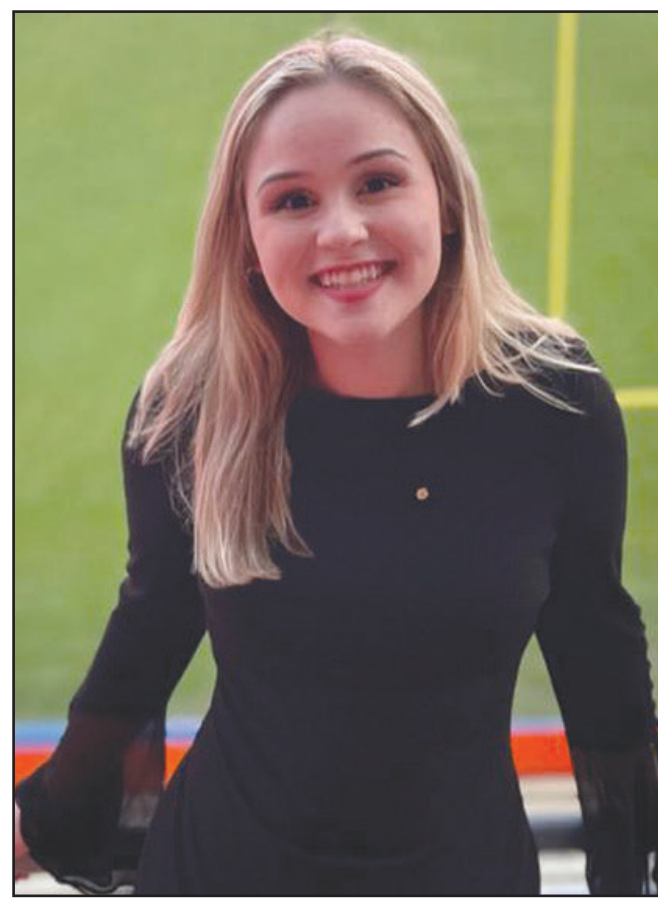
High school and college marching bands must be lead on the performance field by student leaders. Competition for this highest student leadership position is complex.
