

74 Year Old Arrested For 30 Child Pornography Charges

On May 13, 2022, Marion County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) Major Crimes Detective Nicholas Sutliff executed a search warrant on a home in the 6600 block of NW 62nd Avenue after an investigation revealed that the homeowner was downloading and transmitting child pornography. Detective Sutliff interviewed 74-year-old Edward Calvert, who ad-



mitted he was the sole occupant of the residence. Calvert then refused to answer further questions.

The residence was searched and several electronic devices were located, including a desktop computer.

Senior Digital Forensics Technician Jesse Newbanks conducted an extraction of the desktop computer, which resulted in the discovery of additional evidence corroborating that Calvert had downloaded and shared child pornography.

Maricamp Road Grass Fire

On Monday, May 16 at 5:26pm MCFR units were dispatched to the area of the Dunkin' Donuts/Skate Mania on Maricamp Road in reference to a large outside fire. The first units arrived on scene at 5:29pm, immediately calling for additional units. Several 20' piles of oak trees, pine trees and mulch, covering 4.5 acres, were on fire.
