### UP Garden Tractor Pullers

The UP Garden Tractor Pulls are scheduled in Aurora at the intersection of County N and County B for the following summer dates: June 18, July 1, 16, and 30, August 13 and 26, September 10 and 17. All Saturday events start at 3 p.m. and the two Friday events start at 5 p.m. Admission is \$5 for adults and children under 12 are free except car show day is \$10. All gate proceeds go to the Aurora Volunteer Fire department. Food and beverages sold on site and the money earned goes back to the club for improvements. Carry-ins are also allowed.
