LOCATION: 205 Front Street North

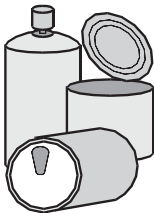
HOURS: Tuesdays and Thursdays 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m.

ITEMS ACCEPTED AND HOW TO PREPARE:

ALUMINUM CANS

Rinse, flatten. **DO NOT MIX WITH TIN CANS.**

NO foil, pie tins, lawn chairs, aluminum doors, or any other aluminum.



TIN/STEEL/BI-METAL CANS

Clean, remove labels, flatten if possible with lids inside of can.

NO paint cans, pesticide cans, car parts, or other scrap iron.

FLUORESCENT LIGHT BULBS

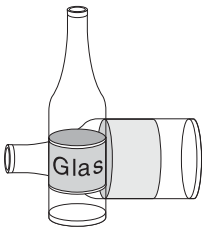
Fluorescent light bulbs will be accepted from residents only, no businesses please.

GLASS BOTTLES and JARS

Clean, remove caps/lids/rings. Labels OK!

Metal lids go in with steel cans.

Sort by color: clear; brown/yellow/green; **NO** opaque colored bottles or jars, lightbulbs, window glass, mirrors, dishes, drinking glasses, mugs, crystal, corning/pyrex/visionware, TV tubes, leaded glass, chemical/medicine bottles, test tubes, candle holders, or any other glass which is not a bottle or jar. **These materials will cause rejection of the entire load.**



PLASTIC #1, #2, #4, #5 & #7 CONTAINERS (# on bottom of bottle)

Clean, remove caps/rings/lids and discard, flatten.

#1 containers (clear/green soda bottles, salad dressings)

#2 containers (narrow-mouth bottles: i.e., milk jugs, orange juice, detergents, shampoos; **wide-mouth containers:** i.e., whip cream, margarine, some cottage cheese, etc.)

NO motor oil bottles, solvent or pesticide bottles, styrofoam, plastic cups, plastic bags and film, hard plastic (toys, pails, etc.), syringes, or any #3 or #6 plastics.
