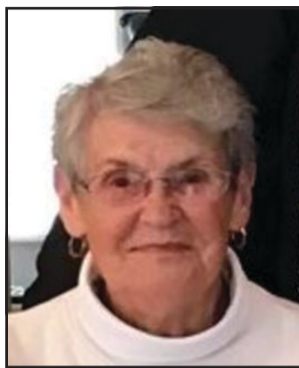


# Obituaries
