

# Arrests made and charges pressed in the month of February

Various charges have been filed and arrests made in Wilkes County over the course of this past month by local law enforcement agencies. The arrests listed here are taken from the limited information in arrest reports provided by local law enforcement officers and no arrests are left out. An arrest does not imply guilt. Criminal charges are merely accusations, and a defendant is presumed innocent unless proven guilty and convicted. Bond and/or release notes contained in this report are as of March 1.
