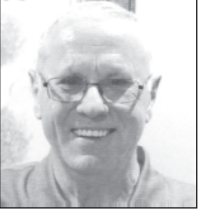


Obituary

1 c. macaroni, cooked and drained
3 eggs, separated
1 T. onion, finely chopped
¾ t. salt
In a saucepan, heat milk over medium heat until bubbles

form around edges of the pan. Remove from heat, stir in the cheese and butter. Let stand for 1 minute. Stir until cheese is almost melted. Stir in bread-crumbs. In a bowl, combine the macaroni, egg yolks, onion, and salt. Stir in cheese mixture. Mix well. Beat egg whites until peaks form, fold in macaroni mixture. Transfer to a greased, 2 qt. baking dish. Bake uncovered at 350 degrees for 30-35 minutes or until puffed and lightly browned.

Baked Beans

½ lb. ground beef
½ lb. bacon
½ onion, chopped
½ c. green peppers, chopped
1 c. ketchup
1 t. mustard

2 t. vinegar
½ t. salt
¼ c. brown sugar
28 oz. pork-n-beans
28 oz. lima beans
28 oz. dk. red kidney beans
In a large skillet, brown ground beef and bacon. Sauté onions and green peppers. Mix together rest of ingredients. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour.

Inside Out Stuffed Peppers

1 lb. hamburger
onion, chopped
1 tomato, chopped
1 lg. green pepper, diced
½ c. rice, uncooked
1 c. water
1 c. pizza sauce
2 t. Worcestershire sauce
½ tsp. salt
¼ t. pepper

1 c. cheddar cheese, shredded

Brown hamburger with onion. Add rest of ingredients except cheese. Bake at 350 degrees for 1½ hours. Uncover and sprinkle cheese on top. Bake 5 minutes longer.

Cabbage Casserole

1 lg. head cabbage, shredded (about 12 c.)
1 onion, chopped
6 T. butter or margarine, divided

1 can cream of mushroom soup

8 oz. American cheese, cubed,

Sale to taste

Pepper to taste

¾ c. dry breadcrumbs

Cook cabbage in salt water till tender, drain. In a large skillet, sauté onion in 5 T. butter until tender. Add soup and mix well. Add cheese, cook, and stir till melted. Remove from heat. Stir in cabbage, salt, and pepper. Put in a 2-quart baking dish. Melt remaining butter and stir breadcrumbs in. Let cook till lightly browned, sprinkle over casserole. Bake uncovered for 20-30 minutes or until heated through.
