Help a Child as did Bill and Andrea Englehardt. Casey Willoughby gave \$200 to the chorus and Eric Arseneau donated \$750 to the Marilyn Davidson Tech Fund.

Benevity/Caleb Englehardt donated \$400 to the high school baseball program, and Moving Forward Advisory Council gave \$500 to the Warrior Store.

In other business, the Board approved opening an activity account for the Builders Club at East Prairie.

The Board accepted resignations from Lacy Diaz, high school cross country coach, and Kim Beachy, technology assistant. They hired Neal Garrison as a counselor and high school cross country coach.

Alexander reported that the school's income is looking good with sales tax revenue up

\$132,000, which he attributed to the Love's Travel Center. He said he expects the personal property replacement tax from the state to also be up.

He also said there would be a special Board meeting at 5 p.m. Thursday at East Prairie.

High School Principal Steve Fiscus announced that the spring musical, The Descendants, will be pushed back a week to March 17-20 due to COVID protocols.
