## Tuscola finishes second in Uni High mini-meet

If Wednesday night was any indication, the Tuscola Lady Warriors have a number of weapons this year. That was more than evident when the Lady Warriors took second, all be it by only four points, at the Urbana University High Mini-Meet. The host school won the meet, the fourth such meet of this year, with 62 points. Tuscola and Caitin Salt Fork took second with 58 points. A total of 14 teams posted a team score in

the 12-event meet, which was held at the University of Illinois Armory. "It was great to have the entire team in action for the first time," said Drew Sterkel, Tuscola's head girl's coach. "We had a chance to see some very talented athletes run their first meet. We have a long way to go, but we are heading in the right direction and have a great start. We only have 22 girls on the roster and we are figuring out what will work best for us

when the outdoor season starts." Alyssa Williams continued to build on her resume as the senior posted an individual first place finish in the 60-meter dash, breaking the tape of 7.82. Centralia's Jenna Wagner, a Class 2A competitor, was second in :08.24. One of Williams' all-state teammates on the 800-meter relay, Mia Hausmann, took 14th in :08.93. Williams also took second

in the long jump, leaping 4.97 meters. Lia Patterson was also a victor and scored points in another individual event. She won the 60-meter hurdles in :09.60 and was third in the long jump, leaping 4.78 meters. Natalie Hastings took third in the shot put. She threw 9.89 meters. Kenna Clodfelder, Addisyn Pettry, Ryleigh Vanausdoll, and Harley Woodard each finished in the top 10. Clodfelder took

fifth in the triple jump. She leapt 9.17 meters. Pettry took sixth in the 60-meter hurdles, finishing in in :10.80. Vanausdoll broke the tape in the 1,600-meter run in 6:36.77, which was good for seventh. Woodard jumped 4.23 meters in the long jump, which was good for ninth. "I am pretty comfortable with my time in the hurdles, but I know I can improve," said Pettry, a sophomore. "I am excited to see my growth in hurdles from the beginning to the end of the season. I plan to get where I want by working hard at practice and listening to my coaches." Olivia Wallace was 13th in the shot put, while Lauren Woods was 15th in the 1,600-

meter run. In the relays, the Lady Warriors ran two relay teams in the 800-meter relay. The Lady Warriors used the eight different runners to take fourth and fifth respectively. The fourth place team finished in 1:58.43. The fifth place team crossed the finish line in 1:59.45. On Thursday, the girl's track team will travel to Mt. Zion for the Mt. Zion Mini-Meet, which will start at 4 p.m. It is their final meet to record their efforts for the Top Times Meet at Illinois Wesleyan University in Bloomington. Those efforts will be highlighted in the article next week.
