Nearly 70 participants attended the event that the Master

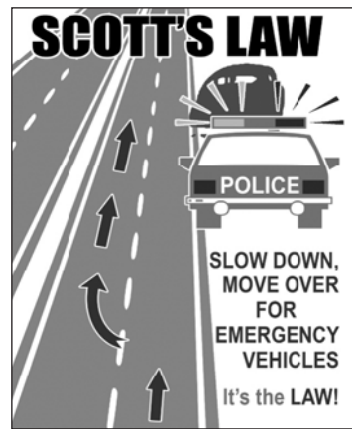
