Chief AJ

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I cluded an interview with Mr. Huffer [http://www.weiu.net/ourstory/tuscola_stream.php]. The following is a transcript of the interview.

I graduated college in 1964, and I went to work for the Department of Children and Family Services for the State of Illinois, and right away I saw there wasn't any facilities for acting out teenage boys who have been declared delinquent from the court. So I looked all over this state for a facility, and right there in Tuscola on Main Street, I found that big old Victorian house. It was 19 bedrooms and six bathrooms, and I moved in with 19 delinquents the day after I bought it.

And Tuscola was really great to me. They let me take my boys to high school, and they got me a judge to sponsor my academy. So from day one in 1965, Tuscola was super great to me.

I started a little construction company along with the boys'

home, and that way I could pay them a little bit of money and everything, so it was after my adopted father died and I went to the lockbox. I was born a half breed at Ford's Crittens Orphan's Home in Peoria, Illinois, and I didn't know my heritage until a year after the state deposit box was opened, and there it had my Native American background.

And in 1980, the State of Illinois needed minority contractors, and so I worked real hard, and the second year, I became minority contractor of the year, and Ronald Reagan's secretary called up and my wife answered the phone there at my house in Tuscola. He said, "This is Gail Hodges, Ronald Reagan's secretary, and you and your husband are invited to the White House, all expenses paid." My wife thought it was one of my buddies playing a joke, and so my wife on the phone said to Reagan's secretary... She said, "I'd like to have that in writing." Twenty minutes later, Western Union telegram came to the door in

writing. We were invited to the White House.

Well, the first record I did, I shot 40,000 in straight flying blocks out of the air, and it took eight days of shooting in a row. So I shot several thousand blocks every day until I got to 40,060, and I broke Annie Oakley's record there and everything. And they put me on the front cover of Guns Magazine, September 1987. And when you get on the front cover of one of those national slick magazines, then they all want you.

Yes, flying targets with a bow and arrow, and I did that right there at 505 South Main Street. All the local TV shows came and everything, and I shot over 5,000 targets. Other people threw them for me, and I shot them. Stuck an arrow in them. There's no doubt about it when you hit them with that.

Tuscola sure has been good to me, and all the things that I've tried to do. They helped me in all my adventures, so I've lived here since '65, and Tuscola is a good place to live.

since he thinks all of it should be covered since the first one caused the other problems.

He said the schools had participated in Alice training, which is an active shooter drill. He noted an email from Kindergarten teacher Jennie Porter, whose students were heard during playtime to shout "Alice, Alice, Alice, we need to get out," showing that they "got it."

It was announced that the Golden Apple program will return to North Ward this summer. The free program doubles as a summer program for kids and on-the-job training for education majors. There will be 8-10 college seniors participating, and the program starts June 6 and runs three weeks.

In other business, the district renewed its contract with Gould Bus Service with a 2 percent increase.

The district also renewed its membership in the Illinois High School Association with no fee. It was noted that fees paid last year will be refunded.

The district hired Russ Leigh & Associates to conduct an annual audit.

The next school election was discussed. Since the Board had to appoint a vacant seat

after the last election, by law voters must be asked on the ballot whether they want to go to an at-large school board election. That question failed during the last election.

Board member Darold Spillman said that the district has learned that four Board members may be elected from one section if at least 75 percent of the voters live in that section. He said most of Tuscola is in one section with 78.9 percent of the registered voters of the school district living there. Four of the voting sections have fewer than 100 voters, he said, while the section with the bulk of the city has 3,046 registered voters.

Donations were accepted as follows: \$500 from Cabot for a North Ward STEAM room, \$400 From Scott and Tina Kibler for high school boys basketball, anonymous donations of \$300, \$200 and \$250 for a high school fan bus, Help a Child and social skills.

Resignations were accepted from Kay Dorner Gates, school psychologist, Mindy Fowler, East Prairie cheer coach, and Eric Hastings, custodian. The Board hired Bill Ludwig as high school Scholastic Bowl coach.
