Memorial service were held Saturday, May 7, at the Edwards Funeral Home. The Rev. Mike Zylstra officiated.

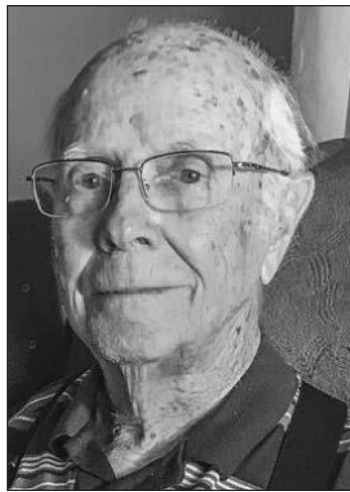

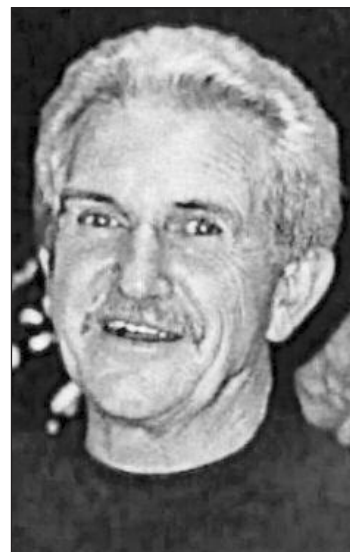
Graveside services were held Thursday, May 5, in the Arthur Cemetery. Lamar Miller will officiate. Military Rites were conducted by the Arthur VFW.
