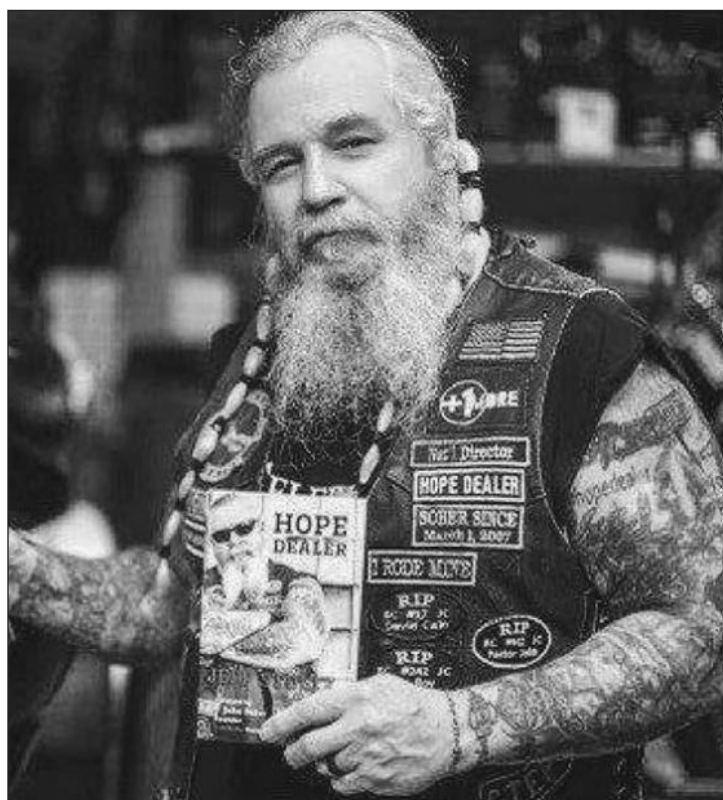
Former gang leader to speak in Camargo

Who is Jeff Stultz? Stultz, right, is the National President of the Celebrate Recovery Broken Chains Motorcycle Ministry, an author, actor, business owner, and Hope Dealer.

He grew up in Fayetteville, N.C. spending most of his adult life as a violent, drug addicted, motorcycle gang leader. After years of time in jail, rehabs, and homelessness, Stultz came to know Jesus Christ. Stultz has become a motorcycle missionary traveling the country to share the Good News that change is possible. He shares his story of a restored life found in the hope and healing of Jesus Christ.

Webinar series busts common conservation myths

The Illinois Sustainable Ag Partnership (ISAP) will be holding a free 3-part webinar series debunking popular myths that keep some farmers from adopting soil health and conservation drainage practices. The series will look beyond the environmental benefits of conservation practices to highlight the production and economic benefits producers can gain by transitioning to a soil health system.

This 3-week series will be held on June 13, 21, and 27 from 1-2:30 p.m. and continuing education credits will be offered.

The first webinar will take on the myth that "Cover Crops Are Just Another Input," exploring the agronomic benefits of taking a systems approach to improving soil health. The second session will review the economic benefits of transitioning to a soil health system, busting the myth that "Conservation Costs Too Much."

The speakers in the final session will take on the widespread belief that "Tile and Conservation Don't Mix," emphasizing ways that tile systems can be designed to mitigate nutrient loss and serve as a foundation for soil health systems. Each session will feature three experts, including a farmer perspective, followed by a facilitated Q&A.

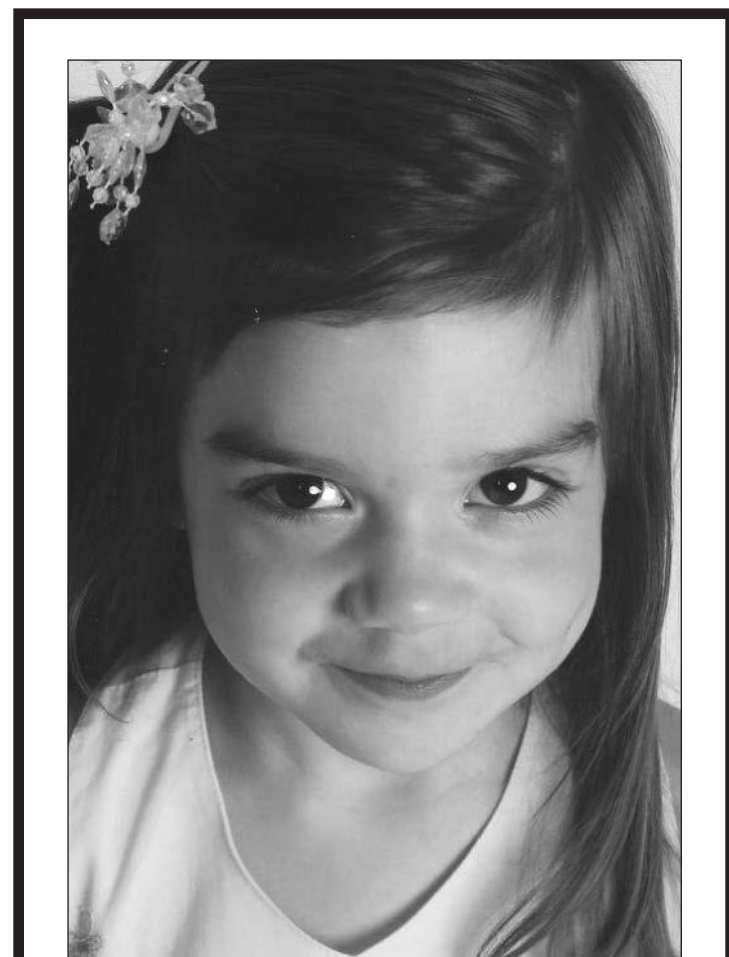
