Gingold, born Baruch Gingold, was born Sept. 20, 1939, in Warsaw, Poland. The hospital he was born in was bombed the day after he was born. His family was sent to the "Warsaw Ghetto," a walled section for about 400,000 Jewish families where the average caloric intake was about a fourth of the recommended daily allowance. His family shared an apartment with one bathroom with three other families. The Gingolds eventually escaped to Russia through a tunnel into an unguarded cemetery. They were sent in a boxcar to live in Siberia and to work in a lumber camp. He said the children used sawdust like an Etch-a-Sketch to work on homework. He didn't attend school until the seventh grade when their family emigrated to Milwaukee. He encouraged the students to practice tolerance to help root out hatred. *Photo by David Porter.*
