Ouarterbacks

Running Backs

that point. Junior Asa Baker, sophomore Ayden Finley and freshman Avery Burks also have a chance to get several reps at the running back spot.

Wide Receivers

A group that includes sophomore Maddox Smith, sophomore Avery McCormick, senior Josh Francis, sophomore Keelan Surratt, freshman Isaac Howard, sophomore Dylan Beach and senior Sam Morgan are all expected to get a lot of playing time playing receiver. Sophomore Kyle Atwood is working hard and coming on strong in a bid for playing time.

Tight End/H-Back

Asa Baker, sophomore Brayden McLemore, junior Prestin James and Avery McCormick are all expected to get plenty of playing time.

Offensive Line

Junior Austin Compton is part of the first group at Center. Filling the Guard spots in the grouping are junior Jeffery Gambrell and junior Kylon Cory. Junior Jared Melton will be playing Right Tackle with senior Joe Holmes manning the Left Tackle position.

Seniors Lee Dornan, Landon Elliot, Joe Wickersheim, along with juniors Corey Petty and Chris Johnson are in the mix and battling for playing time as is sophomore Caden Alley.

Special Teams

Senior Reid Tucker is the new Cardinal Kicker while senior Tristen Graham may also get some duties as well. Avery McCormick will be punting the pigskin for AHS with Asa Baker and junior Austin Compton splitting the Long Snapper duties for punting and kicking. Josh Ginn returns as Holder for extra point kicks and field goals. The Kick Returners group will be made up of a committee made up by A.J. Finley, Malachi Moore, Maddox Smith, Keelan Surratt and Josh Ginn.

Getting playing time at End will be Lee Dornan, Joe Holmes, Jeffery Gambrell, Caden Alley and Landon Elliot.

Nose Guard

Anchoring the middle of the Cardinal defense is a group that is made up of Joe Wickersheim, Jared Melton, Caden Alley, Chris Johnson and Landon Elliot.

Outside Linebacker

Patrolling the outside lanes of the Cardinal defense will be Avery McCormick, Keelan Surratt, Brayden McLemore, sophomore Colton Enzor, Avery Burks and Isaac Howard.

Middle Linebackers

Starting as the anchor in the middle of the defense will be Asa Baker and Prestin James. Sophomore Carson Niukkanen and Kylon Cory will also see playing time from their backup spots.

Cornerback

Sam Morgan, sophomore

Ayden Finley, Josh Francis and Maddox Smith are all part of the rotation getting the bulk of the playing time at Corner. The group is rotating depending on what style and formation their opponent is playing.

Senior Jeremy Lecompte, Kyle Atwood, sophomore Hayden Tate, junior Ryan Conway, Dylan Beach and sophomore Anthony Borden are also playing well and could get in for some snaps.

Safety
