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be spotlighted as “Future World Changers.” We are instilling the importance of education and confidence needed for our students to grow up and change the world using their abundant skills.

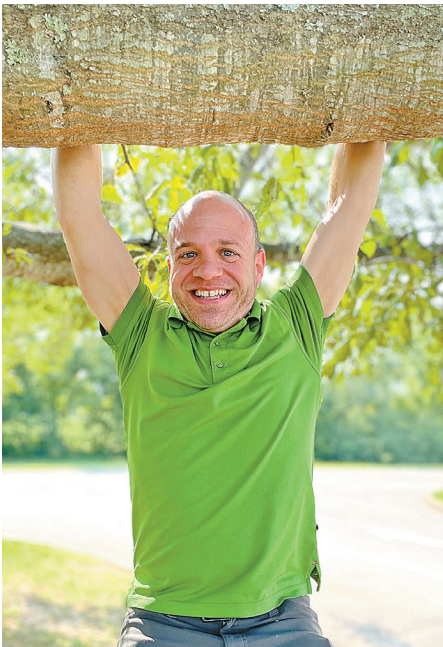
