At Savannah Christian Academy, our mission is to "invest in the discipleship process of students as they grow in knowledge and spiritual maturity." With the highest enrollment in school history, we are delighted to come alongside more families than ever before as partners in investing in and discipling the next generation. SCA's focus on academic growth, spiritual cultivation and athletic progress, has led to successes both in and out of the classroom for 25 years.

Under the guidance of Coach and Administrator Brian Reid, SCA's athletic programs have grown to include basketball, baseball, softball and volleyball. Additionally, SCA hosts a basketball camp each summer for all students in the community in 1st-8th grades. This summer's camp had the highest attendance since the camp began. Students at SCA can begin participating in the

school basketball program as early as the second grade. This "developmental league" approach for second through fifth graders allows students an opportunity to build a foundation in the fundamentals of the sport at an early age. Fourth grade students can participate in softball and baseball at the middle school level. As SCA's newest sports addition, volleyball is available to girls in the sixth, seventh and eighth grades.

Over the last four years,

we have not only seen growth in student enrollment, but have also been able to improve several areas within the school to assist in the academic growth of students. Our science lab has seen a makeover, making it more user friendly for teachers as they conduct experiments and shape young minds to understand the world around them through the lens of God's Word. Students in kindergarten through eighth grade use the science lab weekly to assist and support classroom instruction. Access to technology in the classroom is another area we have improved in recent years, with a one-to-one ratio of students to Chromebooks. Each classroom has also been equipped with a "smart board" for teacher use to aid in the instructional process. We are excited to see how our teachers continue to incorporate these new tools to provide students with an interactive, fun learning environment.

As an accredited institution through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), the spiritual cultivation of

our students will continue to be at the forefront of every aspect of our school day. We are looking forward to walking through what kingdom education means during our weekly chapel times as we begin our school year and being led in worship by our student praise teams. Whether students are in the classroom or on a sports field, we are excited to see how they grow and develop their Biblical worldview and live out what it means to live a "sold out" life to God.
