Poettker is nearing the completion of the first phase of the major, multiyear interior renovation to the connected Health & Business and Library buildings. This facility serves as one of the primary administrative and public space facilities on Kaskaskia's main campus in Centralia, Ill. To achieve this project's goals with limited impact to the students and faculty, Poettker and the college elected to phase the project over two summers. Phase I renovations entailed significant asbestos abatement, HVAC system replacement, and interior finish upgrades to the second floor. Phase II renovation work will focus on the first floor and will take place during the summer of 2023.
