Commenting on board meetings since the partisan change, Carr Ipock, a registered Democrat who has served on the school board for over 30 years, told Ingram, "There was more focus on national agenda items than there was on 'What can we do to make the school system better?" Ingram adds, "Republican legislators arque that partisan elections help voters make more informed decisions by giving them an idea of a candidates' philosophy via their party identification."


