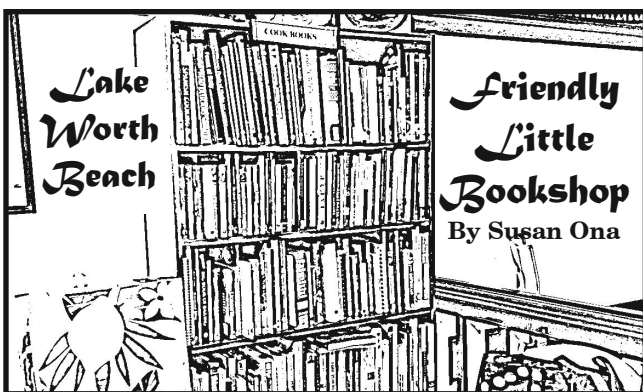

Sandra "Sandi" Dianne Green passed away August 23, 2023, in South Palm Beach, Florida, at the age of 76. Sandi was born November 19, 1946, in Virginia, Minnesota, the oldest of three children, to Robert and Kathryn Johnson. She moved to Lake Worth, Florida with her family in 1961. She was a graduate of Lake Worth High (Class of 1965), Florida State University's School of Education, and received her master's degree in Education from Florida State. Sandi's life was dedicated to the education and inspiration of children, both her own and those in the community. She lived much of her adult life in Council Bluffs, Iowa, where she was a teacher and raised her two children. Sandi was a reading specialist at Rue Elementary and the director of the reading lab at Kirn Junior High. Following her retirement in 2005, she moved back to Florida to spend the next chapter of her life near her parents, her sister Bonnie Purvere and husband Alfred, and her brother Robert Davidsson. While in Council Bluffs, Sandi was a member of Beta Sigma Phi sorority where she made many lifelong friends, and also enjoyed playing bridge and bunco. In Florida, she volunteered for 15 years as a Palm Beach County poll worker, and ushered at the Kravis Center for the Performing Arts and Palm Beach Dramaworks. Sandi enjoyed attending American Association of University Women functions, League of Women Voters meetings, and Lake Worth High School and Phi Mu sorority alumni events. Sandi also loved her ladies book club, Red Hat Society events, and her dining out group.

Sandi is survived by her sister and best friend, Bonnie Purvere (Alfred), two children, Tyler Green (Linda) of Richmond, Virginia, and Laurel Scholl (Andy) of Bettendorf, Iowa, six grandchildren, Amelia, Piper, and Harrison Green, and Zach, Anna, and Kate Scholl. A private burial will be held with arrangements by Dorsey E. Earl Smith Memory Gardens in West Palm Beach, Florida. A Celebration of Life will be held later in 2023 in Council Bluffs, Iowa. Sandi was a lifelong lover of wildlife and volunteered her time and donated to many causes supporting wildlife and National Parks. On September 19, 2023, the City Commission, will consider exchanging the City-owned property located at 610 South H Street for property owned by Dixie Capital Partners, LLC., located at 706 and 710 South H Street to allow for relocation of the City's electric substation as the existing substation is obsolete and needs to be replaced. The following specific information is provided as to the proposed exchange of property that will be considered **Tuesday, September 19, 2023 at 6:00 pm, or as soon thereafter as it can be heard in the City Commission Chamber.** The meeting or public hearing may be continued by the Commission from time to time as required:

- (1) Based on concurrent appraisals for purposes of this exchange there is no difference in value between the City Property and the Dixie Property.
- (2) Decommissioning of the existing City substation will occur by September 30, 2024. The City will pay a monthly fee for any extensions to complete this work.
- (3) The City will have temporary use of a portion of another property owned by Dixie Capital Partners, LLC. to expedite the City's substation relocation project and will pay a monthly fee for the use of that property.
- (4) The exchange will be completed no later than November 30, 2024.
