# GCMS Track & Field hosts CKMSAC

## Lady Dragons win, Dragons runners-up

The Green County Lady Dragon Track and Field Team dominated the Central Kentucky Middle School Athletic Conference meet last Thursday night. They set three new school records and out scored the nearest competition 128-37. The boys' squad finished runner up to a very talented and experienced Campbellsville Middle School team.

Scout Brockman broke her own school records in the discus and shot put (discus-106-08, shot put-39-05) to win both events and claim the #1 spot in both going into Saturday's Middle School State Meet. Dayni Coffey joins Brockman in the school record book, breaking the GCMS girls' record in the 400m dash with a time of 108.05 to win that event. Coffey also PRed in the 200m dash for the win and won pole vault. Coffey will compete at State in pole vault.

Riley Coffey won the 1600m and 3200m runs (after doing the same Tuesday night for Region wins). R. Coffey will compete in the 3200m run at Middle School State. The 4x800m relay team (R. Coffey, Rylee Feese, Lillie Creason, and Kody Pruitt) won the conference title and qualified for the State Meet.

Carly Goff hit a big PR of 4-08 to win high jump and qualify for State. Molly Dixon won triple jump and will compete at State, as well. Callee Talbott finished second to Brockman in shot put and discus. True to recent form, Talbott threw for personal records in both events and has qualified for the Middle School State Meet where she is ranked in the top five in both events.

Dixon claimed first place in the 100m hurdles and 300m hurdles at the CKM-SAC meet. The Lady Dragon 4x400m relay team (D. Coffey, Goff, Bekaha Pruitt, and Dixon) were also conference champs. Lillie Creason won the 800m run with a personal record time. Rylee Feese took second place honors in

Emma Rouse set new personal best marks in the 100m dash and pole vault. Rouse was conference runner up in each of those events, placed third in long jump, and fourth in the 200m dash. Goff was second in long jump and third in the 400m dash. Kody Pruitt was second in the 1600m run and 3200m runs. Bekaha Pruitt was third in triple jump and fifth in the 100m and 200m dashes.


