Formed in 1997, south Kentucky trio One Shot Johnny are International Blues Challenge veterans with semi-final appearances in band, CD and solo categories. Guitarist, vocalist and songwriter Randy Colvin cites many influences on the band's music from blues icons like T-Bone Walker, Freddie and BB King to Allman Bros, Tommy Castro, Tab Benoit and Ronnie Earl. The band's stable of original material runs the gamut - shuffles, boogie, jump and slow blues, rock and jazz-flavored efforts. Joe

Shirley(bass) and Jeremiah Kelly(drums) work almost as a single unit and the band regards dynamics as its fourth member. The band has self-released seven albums of mostly original material over their 25 years together, with their 2009 release Times Like These going to the semi-final round in the IBC's Best Self-produced CD category. In addition to playing in major regional blues festivals around the region, the band has performed in The International Blues Challenge in Memphis twice and proceeded to the semi-finals in 2018.

JOHN MOUNTJOY & STREETCATS - 4:30-5:30



John Mountjoy & The Street Cats are a blend of new age acoustic and contemporary singer-songwriter style music. The 4-piece group have developed a signature sound that stands out from the masses by creating distinctive music that is influenced by old school rhythm blues, 90's grunge, and traditional Appalachian folk. The band is comprised of two married couples, south-central Kentucky locals John & Stasi Smith Mountjoy and Mike & Tiffini Scherbing. Their unique brand of entertainment fuses John's impressive guitar

picking, songwriting, and vocals with a unique rhythm section; a smooth bass line accompaniment from Mike, keep-you-on-your-toes percussion switch-ups by Tiffini- cajon, shakers, tambourines, bass jug, washboard, & spoons to name a few. They are highlighted by Stasi's fiddle & harmonica melodies and vocal harmonies. While the group is newly formed, they mesh so well that you would never guess it. They all have a passion for music that surpasses any amount of experience garnered from time playing together.
