In the race for State Auditor, Republican Allison Ball collected 2,612 votes compared to Kim Reeder's 529

Mark Metcalf, the GOP candidate for State Treasurer, accumulated 2,577 votes compared to Democrat Michael Bowman's 552

Jonathan Shell, the Republican candidate for Agriculture Commissioner, amassed 2,619 votes while Democrat Sierra Enlow collected 525 votes.
