Officials break ground on pedestrian improvement project in Lexington

On Monday, January 23, Central Transportation Commissioner Willie Simmons joined Lexington Mayor Robin McCrory and other officials to break ground on a project that will provide pedestrian and lighting improvements to State Route 12 in Lexington.

"Our focus at the Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) is the safety of all modes of transportation, including pedestrians," said Simmons. "This project will improve safety and mobility for those that need it the most here in Lexington."

The project includes the replacement of existing concrete sidewalks with ADA-compliant sidewalks on SR 12 leading up to the square in
