Minnesota law now requires ALL telephone directories to be recycled. Barnesville Municipal Telephone has the following drop off sites for recycling your telephone directories:

Recycling Center, Barnesville, MN: Tuesday and Thursday, 12-8 p.m. and Saturday, 8 a.m. to Noon.

Recycling Center, Hawley, MN: Monday and Thursday, 4-8 p.m. and Saturday, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Statement Of Nondiscrimination
