Parade line-up beings at 11:00 a.m. at the Clay County Fairgrounds. Units will be exiting from the south gates along Third Avenue SE. If any parade entrants can't go through the gate area, we'll

have them go out the main gate and come around, so please know the height of your unit!

The parade will then turn south on Ninth Street SE until getting to Seventh Avenue SE, where it turns to the west. The route will continue on over to Fifth Street SE, making a turn north to go past Valley Care and Rehab while proceeding under the skywalk between the Barnesville Performing Arts Center and the elementary school.

The route continues to Second Avenue NE where it turns east to return all participants to the fairgrounds through the main entrance.
