- **May 12**
 • Ameren Illinois is partnering with the City of Arcola to upgrade neighborhood streetlights with more energy-efficient LED (light-emitting diode) streetlights.
- Arcola coach Beckie Headrick was named the "Coach of the Year" for Special Olympics and was presented a plaque on April 29.

- A total of 12 members of the Arcola boys' and girls' track team, including alternates, qualified to participate in the IESA Class 2A state track meet set for Friday and Saturday at the EastSide Centre in East Peoria.

- **May 19**
 • Arcola Lions Club posthumously recognized Lion Dianne Conlin Murphy as its Lion of the Year for 2021-2022.
- Senior Beau Edwards not only surpassed his school record in the 800 (1:59.75) with a time of 1:58.40 and not only that he beat the second place runner by 7.36 seconds in the 39th annual Champaign-Urbana News-Gazette Honor Roll meet Monday at the Gene Armer Track.

- **May 26**
 • Arcola Principal Lisa Ann Sigrist, age 55, of Arcola, passed away Monday, May 23, following a battle with cancer.
- For the second straight year Arcola's Mitchel Myers and Beau Edwards have qualified for the Class 1A state track and field meet by placing first or second in their respective events. Myers is in the shot put and discus, while Edwards is in the 400, 800 and high jump.

- **June 2**
 • Beau Edwards set his fourth school record May 26

in the IHSA Class 1A state preliminaries in the 400 with a time of 50.75 breaking the mark of 51.13 set by Mark Klinger in 2008.

- **June 9**
 • Arcola freshman Tanner Thomas was named one of three first team unanimous selections on the 2022 all-Lincoln Prairie Conference baseball team. In addition, senior Beau Edwards was one of 11 players named to the first team as voted on by the conference coaches (can't vote for your own player).
- The Arcola City Council approved a slew of bids for park improvements Monday night. City Administrator Bill Wagoner said the city received no bids for general contractor to coordinate all the projects, so he and City Foreman Gary Lampe have been acting in that capacity.

- **June 16**
 • The annual Miss Arcola Pageant is June 18.
- The Arcola School Board has frequently praised its staff for their work throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. Last Wednesday, they used part of the district's federal relief funds to reward the staff. The Board approved a one-time bonus of \$1,000 for all full-time staff members and \$500 for all part-time staff.
- In the inaugural season for the Arcola Riders Eastern

Illinois Baseball League, picked up their first victory Sunday in the second game of a doubleheader against the Paxton Swedes at Moore Memorial Park.

- **June 23**
 • Libman Company's past came back recently in the form of a school bell that once hung above the old East Side school in Arcola. After relocating to a warehouse on Wilson Street in Tuscola in the 1930s, the company outgrew its space and moved into the old Arcola school in 1957, traces of which can still be seen today on the plant floor, which now has 2 million square feet of modern manufacturing and warehousing space..
- Cadet James Samuel Crane, son of Jim and Rachael Crane of Arcola, graduated from the U.S. Military Academy on Saturday, May 21.

- **June 30**
