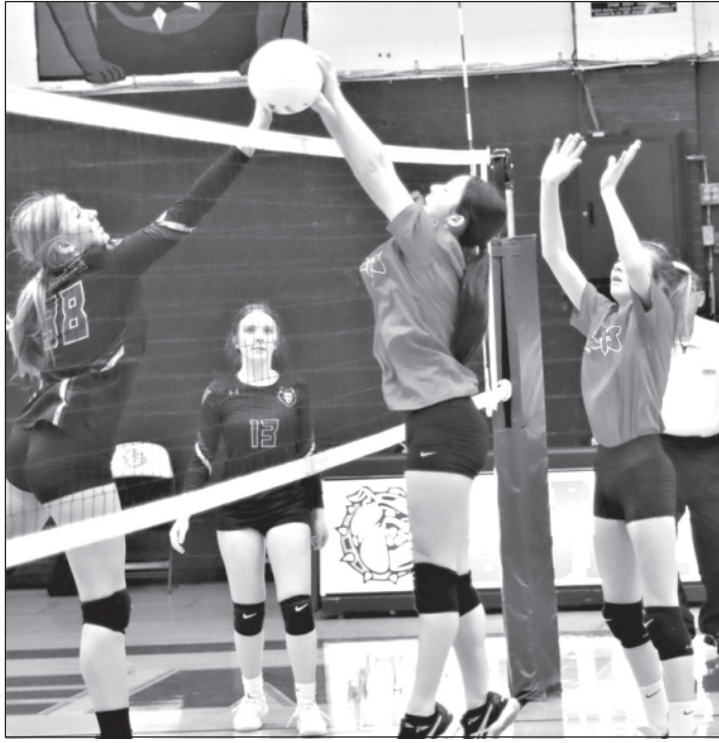


# ALAH JR HIGH VOLLEYBALL @ JHOC TOURNNEY
