was very evident. He has as much passion for teaching as he does coaching, which is great. He and his family (wife Kim, a Maroa-Forsyth grad, who will be a high school English teacher at Arcola; and eight month old son Carter) will be great additions to the Arcola family."

From Orangeville, Snider began his collegiate career at Eureka where his resident assistant was none other than Lindsey, who was a senior in the 2009-10 school year. At Eureka Snider and Lindsey played under current coach David Barth, a 1998 Eureka grad. Barth went 4-6 his first season in 2009 at Eureka, a Division III football program. They went 2-8 and 4-6 Snider's last two seasons.

After Eureka he returned to Orangeville where he was an assistant coach from 2013-2019 all under Jay Doyle, including playoff appearances from 2017-19 in Class 1A. The 2019 team went 7-4 and lost to the eventual champions, Lena-Winslow 52-8 in the second round. Finally he moved up to head coach only to have it be the COVID-19 season of 2020-2021. It was the last 11-man football team for Orangeville, who went to 8-man with an enrollment of 107.5.

"That was interesting and I

was also athletic director at that time," said Snider, whose wife is the softball coach at Morrison this season after coaching Forreton from 2018-2022, including a third place finish in Class 1A last season. "That was challenging in every way you could possibly think of, but it was fun. When we finally got the word that everything was going to happen it was a lot of fun because the kids were so excited to get the opportunity to have some of a season and it was awesome. Everyone was ecstatic, but it was definitely different being the head coach."

In the 2018 season Orangeville traveled four and half hours to play at Cumberland on a Saturday game with the Broncos winning 32-28.

In 2021 Snider was hired as the last new football coach at Morrison replacing Ryan Oetting, who coached the Mustangs for three seasons, going 15-11 including a quarterfinal appearance in 2019, going 11-1. Morrison, a school with an enrollment of 279 and won two Class 2A state titles in 2009 and 2011.

Snider's first season was 2-7, but he was 5-5 last year making the Class 1A playoffs before losing to Ottawa Marquette 20-6.

"It was a hard decision," said Snider of leaving Morrison. "We only graduate

four and have a lot of athletes coming back. It is never an easy conversion (to tell the team you are leaving) and there was a lot of sadness, but a lot of excitement as those boys know me and I know them. They were just as happy to see me get another great opportunity even though it was hard to see me go."

Snider is 8-16 in two years plus the COVID year.

"We had always planned to get a little bit closer to my wife's family in Maroa and getting to Morrison was an hour closer than Orangeville. When the opportunity popped up I thought it was a good opportunity (at Morrison). I was not out of my comfort zone at Orangeville and I wanted to prove that just because I was in my hometown I could do well elsewhere. I had a lot of fun and did a lot of good things at Morrison"

Asked what the difference was between the first and second season Snider said, "I think it was just being able to be there the entire time as I was approved by the Morrison board in June and that left me starting in late May. Just having no time there and to get things started and meet with the other staff members or get a staff together was frustrating and challenging. Having a full year and a whole summer that the staff was able to work made it a lot easier for me.

Being hired in March at Arcola gives me the opportunity to meet the kids three months before I was able to in my first year at Morrison. I am excited about that situation."

Snider will be working on getting a staff together, including talking to the assistant

coaches from last fall that are interested.

Snider was a construction tech at FS until earning his license and taught construction and ag in 2015 at Orangeville. When he went to Morrison he got his business endorsement and taught business and technology at Morrison.

His wife Kim is also a Eureka grad

"We are both big into teaching and coaching and we both love it and that is why we fit so well together," said Snider.

"Eureka is a tight community and I know Nick would say the same thing that coach Barth made an impact on our lives that is second to none. I am looking forward to working with Nick in football and in the classroom with him being principal. The closeness of Eureka makes it always more special when you do share the same type of values and you know each other a little bit."

Snider, who said he heard of the job opening from a LeRoy assistant coach Jon Deedrick, a classmate of Snider's at Eureka, becomes the 30th coach since 1912 (program started in 1894, but coaches names are not available).

"I had all my ducks in a row and did everything I could," said Snider of the interview and resume process. "I wanted to be a part of that tradition. I think it is special when you get to work for an administration that you know you can trust. I have someone (Lindsey) to lean on and that I know will be there for me. I trust Nick implicitly. This is the type of place where I want to coach and teach all the years I have left."


