## Myers breaks own indoor shot put record

 URBANA - Arcola senior Mitchel Myers broke his own school indoor shot put record last Saturday at the Rantoul Invitational held at the University of Illinois Armory. It was the second of three indoor meets scheduled for Arcola. Myers went 51-5.76, eclipsing his mark set last week by 1-5.76.

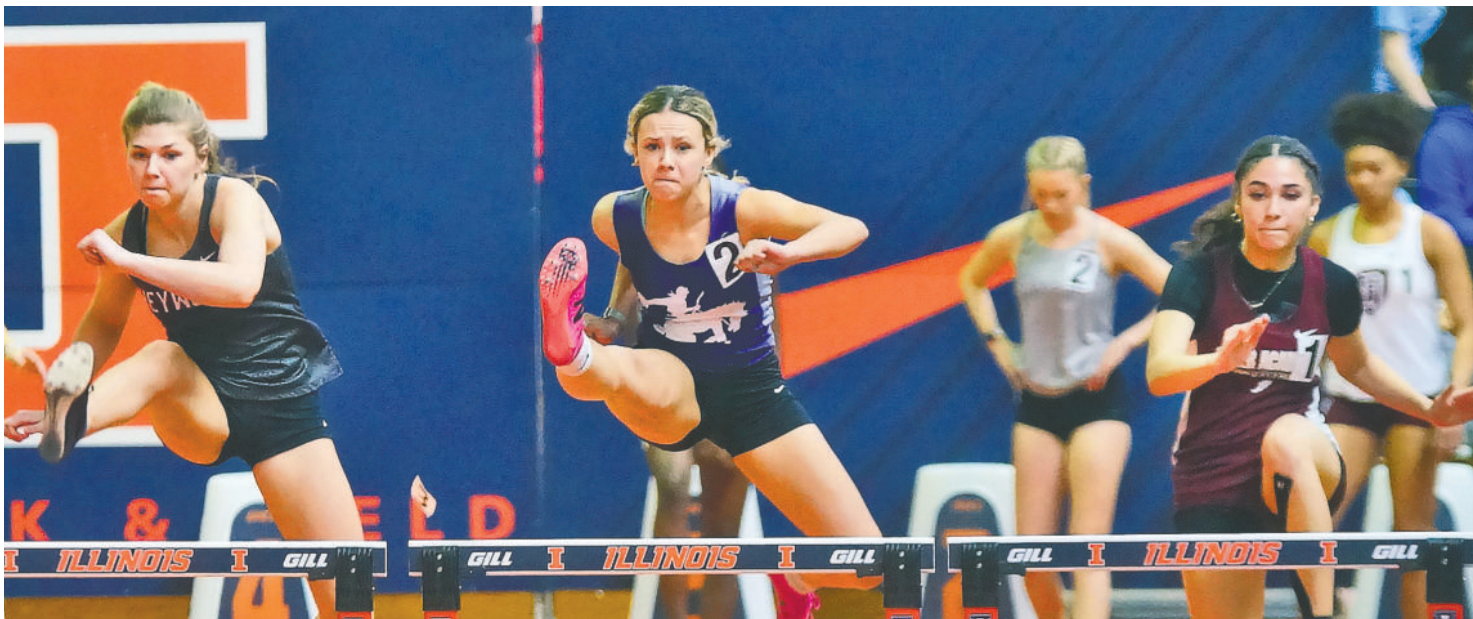
A total of 34 teams competed in the non-scoring event. There were 17 Class 1A teams, 10 Class 2A and 7 Class 3A teams all competing against each other.

On the girls' side the highest place finish was eighth by Ema Simpson in the long jump, going a personal record of 15-1.5. Kelsey Moore was 10th in the 400 with a personal record time of 1:07.06 and was also 19th in the 60 hurdles with a personal

record time of 10.85 seconds. Simpson was also 13th in the 60 meter dash with a time of 9.04 seconds. Both of Simpson's results were personal records. Eva Hopkins was 14th in the triple jump at 28-2.25 and Crystal Ramirez was 14th in the high jump at 5-6

Back to the boys side where Aden York was 20th in the 800 (2:16.28), Ryan Lindstrom 21st in the triple jump (36-3) and Braden Phillips was 11th in the triple (38-7.5).
