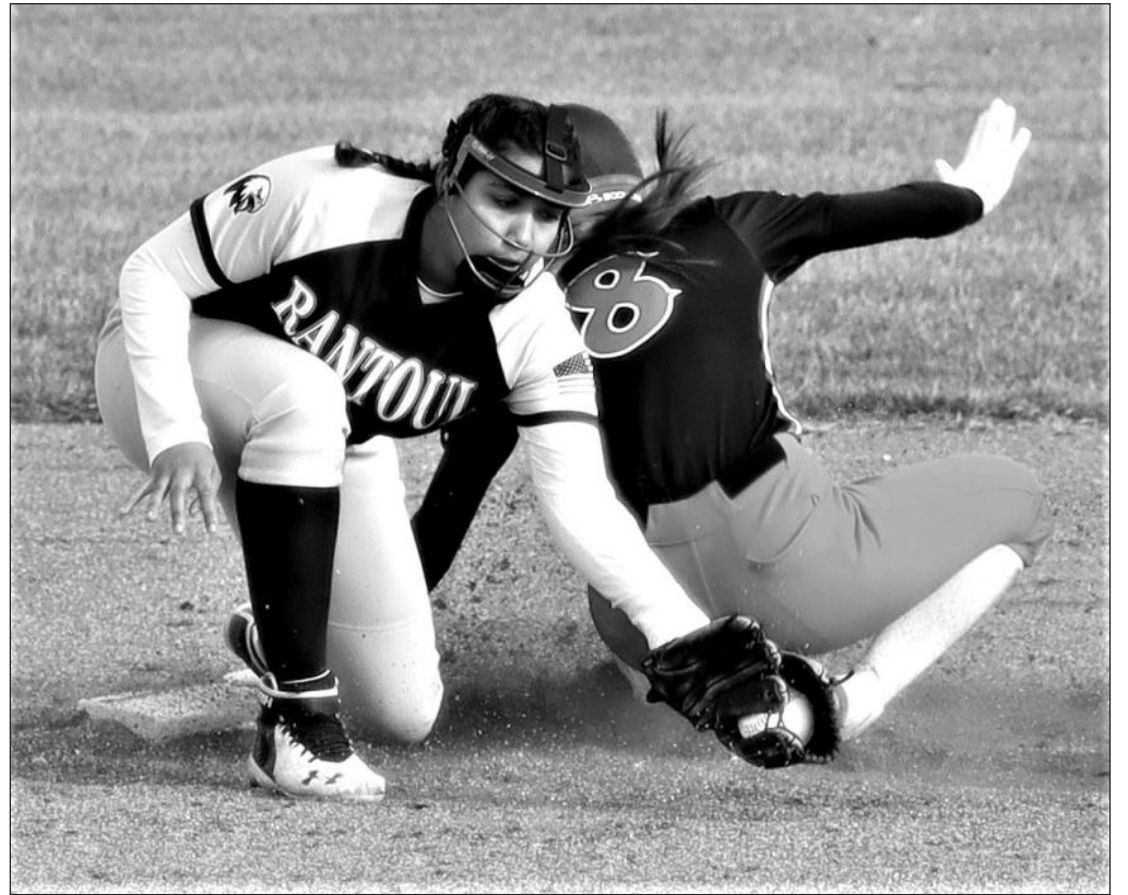


ALAH HIGH SCHOOL SOFTBALL AND BASEBALL
