## Myers continues to excel; Moore shines for AHS girls

**MONTICELLO** – In the 18 team boys' track Monticello Invitational Arcola senior Mitchel Myers continues to excel not only in that meet, but the five-team meet April 11 at Assumption (hosted by Central A&M).

It was the meet on April 11 that Myers established another school record going 53-5 in the shot put winning the event by 14-1 over the second place finisher. He also won the discus with a throw of 171-3, winning by 44 feet!

Last Friday at Monticello Myers was second in the discus at 166-9 and third in the shot put at 51-1. Ryan Lindstrom also placed as he went 38-0 in the triple jump, good for seventh place.

Sullivan won the meet with 90 points, while Arcola was fifth with 37.5 points.

April 11 the 4x200 relay team of Aden York, Braden Phillips, Elian Arguilera, Oden Barron ran the event in 1:39.01 and Lindstrom was second in the triple jump at 39-1 and third in the long jump, going 18-3.

### Moore has great day

On the girls side Kelsey Moore shined in the meet April 11. Not only did she win the 300 hurdles in 18:26, but was second in the 800 with a season-best time of 2:54.30 and second in the 100 hurdles in a season-best time of 18.26. She was also on the third place 4x100 that finished with a time of 54.59. Eva Hopkins, Crystal Ramirez and Ema Simpson were the other three

in the relay. Simpson was also second in the long jump at 15-0, while Ramirez was second in the long jump at 4-7 Also placing second with the 4x200 relay that consisted of Hopkins, Emma Vazquez, Ramirez and Simpson. They crossed the finish line in 2:00.46.

As a team the girls scored 31.5 points, good for third in the meet won by Cerro Gordo/Bement with 103 points.
