

32nd Arthur Amish Country Quilt Show April 27-29 at the Otto Center

A variety of quilts will be displayed at the 32nd Annual Arthur Amish Country Quilt Show Thursday through Saturday, April 27-29, at the Otto Center (2056 County Road 1800 East) just one-half mile south of Arthur.

The show will be open 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday and Friday and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday. There is a small admission fee.

In addition to the quilts in the exhibit, close to another 100 pieces will be sold during the annual auction on Saturday, April 29 starting at noon.

Entries will be judged in each of five categories: Baby, Wall Hanging, Antique, Pieced (pieced machine quilted and pieced hand quilted), and Mixed Techniques. Ribbons and gift certificates will be awarded for first, second, and third place in each category along with the Best of Show winner receiving a \$100.00 gift certificate and all are

redeemable for merchandise at participating Arthur merchants. Visitors to the show will determine the winner of the People's Choice Award ribbon.

Those in attendance will also have the opportunity to enter a raffle drawing to win a queen-size Double Wedding Ring quilt. The drawing will take place on Saturday afternoon.

In addition to the quilts on display, there will be a market/vendor area and a lunch stand with cheeseburgers and barbecue sandwiches, wraps, taco salads, cinnamon rolls, desserts, and drinks available by the Kitchen of Doris Yoder.

The Arthur Quilt Show has become the largest spring quilt exhibition in Illinois Amish Country. It attracts entries from all over Illinois, including many Amish-crafted quilts.

Thomas. "Then I heard a loud bang and I saw all of the glass falling down. I was not expecting that."

It was similar to the movie the Natural only this was foul and at the first light pole on the third base side of home and not a towering home run that hit the lights and caused all of the lights to go out and sparks to fly.

Offensively, Arcola was led by Tanner Thomas who had a double, going 2-for-4 with five runs batted in. Whisman was 3-for-4 with four RBIs and Phillips was 3-for-4 with a double and four RBIs. The No. 9 batter, Austin Kutz was 2-for-3 with 3 RBIs.

"Overall, it was a good game," said Phillips. "We hit the ball and that is the key for us."

Cerro Gordo had its three-game winning streak snapped. The Broncos, coached by Bement graduate John Strack, who is married to Kim Fay, daughter of former Arcola teacher Richard Fay, are 4-6 overall and 2-3 in the LPC, good for sixth place.

Arcola 23, Blue Ridge 1, 5 innings

Arcola had at least one run in every inning, including two eight-run innings in the sec-

ond and the fifth inning as the game was never in doubt after the second.

The Purple Riders used three pitchers in Caiden Helmuth, Jackson Griffith and Braden Phillips. The three combined to allow just one hit with two walks and 10 strikeouts meaning only five outs were not strikeouts.

Offensively, seven batters had at least two hits. Thomas was perfect in five at-bats with a triple and two doubles and three RBIs and Phillips was also 5-for-5 with a double and five RBIs. Arcola had six doubles and three triples in the game at Farmer City.

Sullivan 7, Arcola 2

Arcola was No. 10 in the Champaign-Urbana News-Gazette entering the game. Sullivan moved into the No. 10 spot the following week after the five-run victory.

The Redskins scored two in the second and one in third, while Arcola had one in the third. In the fourth Arcola cut the deficit to one as Shonkwiler led off with a walk, Kutz sacrificed him to third and Shonkwiler scored when Thomas reached on an error by the shortstop. However, the Redskins turned a 6-3 double play to end the inning.

Sullivan increased its lead to 7-2 when with one out the

leadoff batter, Tristan Ruppert hit a double and scored on a single by Jake Stewart followed by a one-run double by Dawson Foster. The cleanup batter, Adan Mills, hit a two-run homer over the fence in left field for a 7-2 lead.

Arcola didn't go quietly into the night as they had bases loaded with one out when Shafer Ogle struck out the last two batters to end the game.

Thomas suffered the loss for Arcola, while Sullivan's Stewart earned the win.

"It is the first time I have seen Tanner Thomas and he is really good," said Sullivan coach Jason Badman. "Jayden Henson-Stice is no slouch either. At the end of the day we strung the hits together in the seventh. Fallon Rose (a freshman) had a big two-run single (in the second). Stewart was sick most of last week and he just got tired that and we had him on a pitch count and had to take him out. He is not close to 100 percent."

Badman, a former Mattoon Post 88 coach and coached the Mattoon 15-year-old Babe Ruth team to state title in 2012, was happy to be at a place he played (field went from southwest to northeast).

"Overall I am looking forward to being in the LPC (next year) where we only

play each other once," said Badman, a 1997 Villa Grove graduate and former all-Little Okaw Valley Conference catcher. "In the Central Illinois Conference we play each team twice.
