

Knights JH Boys Track Teams Compete in Home Triangular

The Arthur Lovington Atwood Hammond Jr. High boy's track teams played hosts to Cumberland and Villa Grove on April 11. Both the seventh and eighth grade teams finished second to Cumberland.

Alex Olivero was a double winner for the seventh grade taking first place in both the shot put and discus. Winning individual events in the seventh grade were Bentley Hutson in the 400 meters and Colton Snyder in the 1600. The 4 X 200-meter relay team of Hutson, Olivero, Anden Berry and Jase Kingery won that race in a time of 2:04.18.

Max Boddy led the way for the eighth grade taking two individual firsts in the 100 and 200 meters and running a leg on the victorious 4 X 200 meter relay along with Josh Taylor, Tyler Lisanby, and Mason Thomas. Cooper Shoemaker, high jump and Preston Gingerich, 1600 meters were the other eighth grade event winners.

The Jr. High boys' track teams will hit the road for a meet at Tuscola on April 20, the Arcola JH Invite, April 22, a multi-team meet at Sullivan on April 24, the Mt. Zion Invite on April 29, the JHOC meet at Tuscola on May 1 before returning home for a triangular meet with Sullivan and Tuscola on May 9.
