The Arthur Lovington Atwood Hammond Jr. High girls' track and field teams had a home triangular meet with Cumberland and Villa Grove on Tuesday, April 11. The seventh-grade squad finished second in the team standings behind Cumberland and ahead of Villa Grove. The eighth-grade girls were victorious in their division.

Emily Keagle, shot; Laila Sanchez, discus; Macelyn Boddy, high jump and Sophie Johnson, 400 meters were individual event winners for the seventh grade. They took two of the three relays, the 4 X 200 meter of Bri Clayton, Sanchez, Layla Beck and Boddy and the 4 X 400-meter relay of Norma and Zoey Mendoza, Johnson, and Gwen Herring.

Morgan Casteel was a double winner for the eighth grade in the 800 and 1600 meter runs and anchored the winning 4 X 400-meter relay. Cassidy Rohacs took individual honors in the 100-meter hurdles and ran legs on the winning 4 X 100 meter and 4 X 400-meter relays. Other first place relay members were on

the 4 X 1 Maleyna Vanausdoll, Reece Oye and Riley Strode and on the 4 X 4 Reece Oye and Embrey Reardon.

The Jr. High Knights track teams will travel to Tuscola on Thursday, April 20, 2023 after hosting their annual ALAH JH Invitational on Saturday, April 15 and then compete in Arcola's annual Invite on April 22.
