Simpson places in three events in fresh-soph meet; Myers and Moore shine in Friday's meets

TUSCOLA -Ema Simpson placed in three events on a windy Monday night in the Tuscola freshmen-sophomore Invitational in the meet that had no scoring. Simpson was the 100 and 400 runner-up with times of 13.40 and 1:03.22, both season bests. She won the long

jump, going 14-6. Friday in the boys 37th St. Joseph-Ogden Spartan Classic Mitchel Myers was second in the discus at 167-0 and third in the shot put at 50-5. The girls traveled to Cumberland for the Lady Pirate Invitational Friday and Kelsey Moore was the runner-up in the 300 hurdles with a
