Storm safety tips from National Weather Service

The National Weather Service gives a few tips on preparing.

- Create a Communications Plan: Set safe locations in your house, such as a basement, storm cellar, or an interior room on the lowest floor with no windows.
- Prepare an Emergency Kit: Ensure you have it in your home, work, and car. Your kits

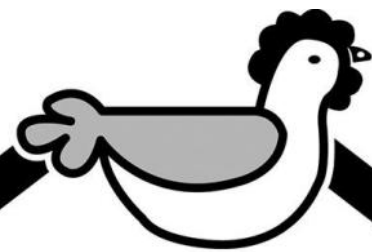
should include water, food, a flashlight, a first aid kit, extra batteries, a whistle, a dust mask, plastic sheeting and duct tape, moist towelettes, garbage bags, plastic ties, a wrench, pliers, a manual can opener, cell phone with charges.

- Ensure all house members know where to go when a warning is issued. Run your

drills and have your pets involved as well.

- Keep trees and branches trimmed near your house. Identify loose objects that you have outside and have the plan to secure them when severe weather hits. Close windows and doors.
- Think about how you can help someone else. Go ahead and take CPR training.
