Pick-up of quilts after the show is Saturday, June 24 at 2:30 p.m. Your quilts, unless vintage, need to be clean and in good condition. Forms for each quilt will be available at the center when you bring in your quilts or they can be downloaded on the Sew Happy Hearts Facebook page. There is no fee for quilt entries. Please measure your quilt sizes on the forms, though they can help with measuring when you bring them in.

Proceeds from the show are directed to various charitable organizations. The guild has donated quilted and sewn items to veterans groups, homeless shelters, area children's homes and schools.
