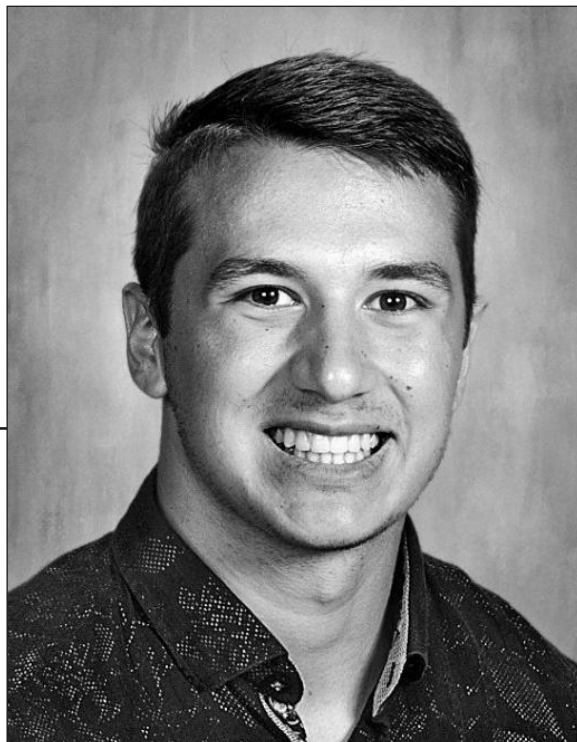

J'Lea Nicole York

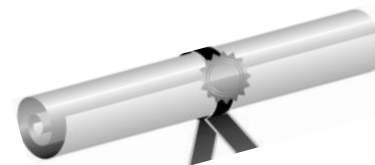
J'Lea is the daughter of Rick and Melody York.
