Drug overdose prevention program sites now available throughout county

 Several organizations across Douglas County have partnered with Recovery Orientated System of Care (ROSC) to provide Drug Overdose Prevention Program (DOPP) sites. So far, six sites in Douglas County are participating in the program. Arthur Public Library District, Newman Regional Library District, Atwood-Hammond Public Library, Tuscola United Methodist Church, Camargo Township District Library and Rural Grace Food Pantry in Murdock. Narcan and Narcan training is also available through the Douglas County Health Dept under a separate program. The Health Department has a "harm-reduction box" which includes a variety of items that can help people, including Narcan. The sites serve the communities by providing free and confidential access to Narcan nasal sprays, which reverse overdoses caused by opioids.

According to the California Department of Public Health, Narcan, the FDA-approved nasal spray form of naloxone, is an essential tool in responding to the opioid crisis. Narcan does not require medical training to administer and has no harmful effects if given to someone who is
