Steven, of Alabama; and his brother, Rodney, of Germantown Hills.

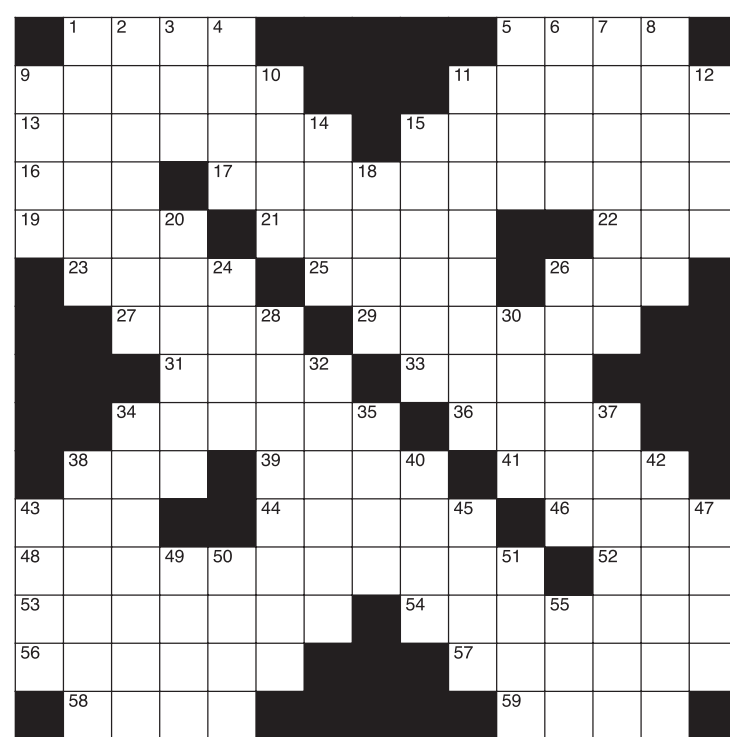
