Wanda Louise Dilliner, 96, of Arcola died at 10:53 a.m. Thursday, July 20, 2023, at Amber Glen Assisted Living in Urbana, surrounded by her family.

Funeral services were held Sunday, July 23, at the Arcola United Methodist Church with Pastor Seth Emerson officiating. Burial followed in the Arcola Cemetery. Visitation was held Sunday at the church. Shrader Funeral Home, Arcola, assisted the family with arrangements.

She served as an election judge, Room Mother, Girls' Booster Club president, PTA president and delivered Meals on Wheels. She was a 64-plus-year member of the Arcola United Methodist Church, where she served on several boards, taught Sunday School, helped with Bible School and was an active member of the Methodist Women and Ladies' Circle.

Wanda was involved with the activities of her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren and loved spending time with them.
