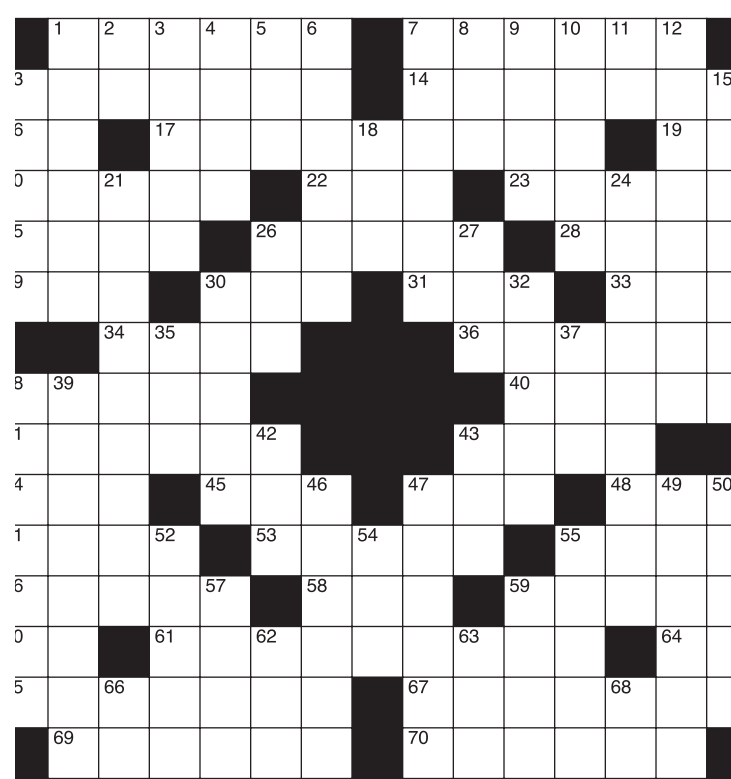

Arcola Eastern Illinois baseball league falls

ARCOLA – The second ever season for the Arcola Eastern Illinois Baseball League has been a struggle. The last two doubleheaders are no exception. The Riders lost to Paxton Sunday at Arcola's Moore Memorial Park 13-0 in five innings and 10-2 in seven innings.

July 16 Arcola traveled to Decatur to play the Decatur Commodores, who are in their first season and the Riders fell 7-3 in what was the closest game of the year. The Commodores won the other game 12-2.

Arcola plays host to the Buckley Dutchmasters Saturday at 3 p.m. in a one game only contest. Buckley is 13-1

and in first place, while the Riders are 0-13.

Paxton 10, Arcola 2

Paxton, a team that was 7-7 before the contests, led Arcola just 4-2 after three innings, but they added three in the fourth and three in the seventh, while holding the

Riders to just two hits.

Colin Sullivan picked up the win throwing four and a third innings and allowing no hits with four strikeouts. Alex Barney led the offense for Paxton going 2-for-4 with a double and four runs batted in.

Arcola stats were unavailable.

Paxton 13, Arcola 0

Paxton jumped out to a 4-0 lead after one inning and led 12-0 after three, including a six run third inning.

The Swedes held Arcola to four hits as Zach Carr was the winning pitcher allowing four hits in four innings and

striking out seven. Offensively, Paxton was led by Connor Allen, who was perfect in four at-bats with a double, a triple and three runs batted in.

Arcola stats were unavailable.

Decatur 12, Arcola 2

Decatur doubled the Riders in a seven game called after seven innings due to the 10-run rule. Arcola was held to four hits, two of which were by Gustavo Trevino. Other hits for the Riders were by Trevor Froehling and Miguel Gonzalez.

Seth Gossett took the loss giving up eight runs, four

earned in four innings.

Decatur 7, Arcola 3

Arcola had seven hits, including two each by Trevino and Froehling, but it was not enough. Gonzalez was 1-for-4 with two runs batted in.

Juan Ramirez took the loss allowing seven runs, four earned in six innings.
