## NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

New students to the district must visit their corresponding school for more registration information.

Documents Needed for Students

- Birth certificate (new students)
- School physical exams/proof of immunizations: New students, K, 6th, 9th grade. Freshmen immunizations should include 2 doses of Vari-

cella Vaccine.

• Seniors: Meningococcal vaccine or Meningococcal booster if needed (Ask your physician or local health department if one is needed.)

• Dental Exam: K, 2nd, 6th, 9th grade

• Vision Exam: K

• Sports Physical (JH & HS athletes) - Freshman physical counts as sports physical

### Cafeteria Operation

The USDA free meal program

for all has expired. Students will be charged full meal prices for 2023-2024.

Breakfast will be served on a daily basis for \$2.20 per day. Lunch can be purchased by students in kindergarten through fifth grade for \$3.05 per day and by students in grades 6-12 for \$3.25 per day.

To apply for free or reduced priced meals, please fill out the Food Service Application in Skyward Family Access on a computer. This is not accessible through the app. If you have any questions, call your school office after August 1.

At the high school an "Ala Carte" line will be offered. This line has a variety of single items

with the menu varying slightly each day. Students must have money in their food service account to charge any ala carte items.

### Arthur Crossing Guard

Parents living west of Vine Street are reminded that an adult crossing guard is on duty at the intersection of Vine and Park streets. This is the safest place for students of any age to cross Vine Street.

### Physical Exams

Physical examinations are required by state law of all students entering pre-school, kindergarten, and sixth and ninth grades plus new students entering the school district for the first time.

This law will be adhered to by Arthur Lovington Atwood

Hammond Schools. Any child not having a complete and current physical examination record and immunization record will not be admitted to class.

They will be sent home and counted absent until the school receives a completed health record or until arrangements have been made with the building principal.

New students and those entering kindergarten and second, sixth, and ninth grades are also required by school policy to have current dental examinations on file.

Arthur and Lovington grade schools will provide dental exams through Sarah Bush Lincoln Health Center.

Kindergarten students must also have vision exams in addition to the school physical.

Students participating in athletics must have a physical exam on file before the first day of practice.

### Attendance Policy

All absences will require an excuse in writing from the parents or guardian of the students. Each student will present this excuse to the office before reporting to class. The office will issue a pass which will be marked "excused" or "unexcused."

All absences due to health reasons, a death in the immediate family, a family emergency, or a dental or medical appointment are "excused."

Absences for reasons other than those listed above will be "unexcused."

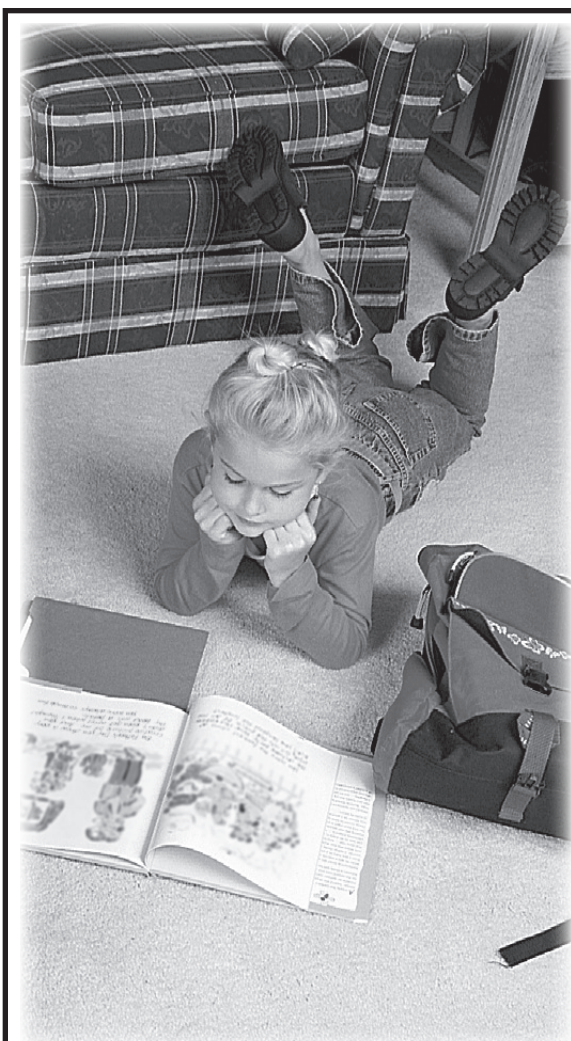
Students with an "unexcused" absence may not attend or participate in after school activities.

### Notification Of Absences

According to state law, schools are responsible for making a reasonable effort to contact the parents of each child who is absent from school. This must be done each school day.

If a child is going to be absent from school, we ask that parents call the school office before 9 a.m. (Arthur Grade School, 543-2109; ALAH High School, 543-2146; Lovington Grade School, 873-4318; or At-

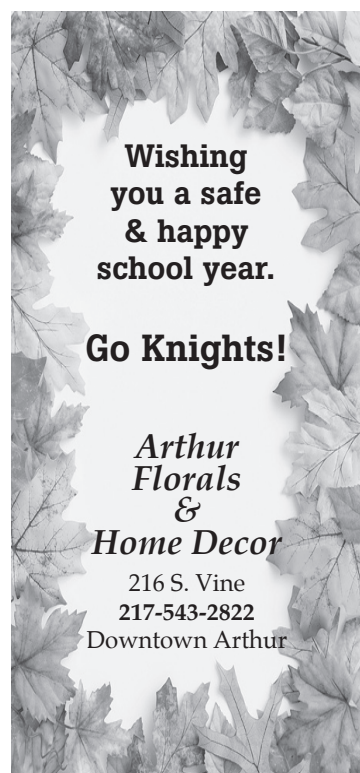
