shootings throughout the country, such officers also provide a quick response to emergencies.

Mulligan said he has talked to Arcola City Administrator Bill Wagoner, who agreed to bring it up with the city's police committee Aug. 21. Mulligan said he would post notice for the school district so School Board members may participate in that meeting.

Mulligan noted that Charleston schools are adding a resource officer. "I want to get the conversation going," he said.

In other business, the Board set a date for a hearing on its tentative budget for 7 p.m. Sept. 13.

They also approved their risk management plan, which defines eligible tort fund expenditures. Mulligan said the district does not pay all eligible expenses out of the tort fund in an effort to maintain a consistent tax rate for the fund. "We don't want to increase the tax rate," Mulligan said.

The Board also approved hiring Desi Thomas as the high school football cheerleading coach and James McCrate as a paraprofessional. New teachers will be invited to the September Board meeting, he said.

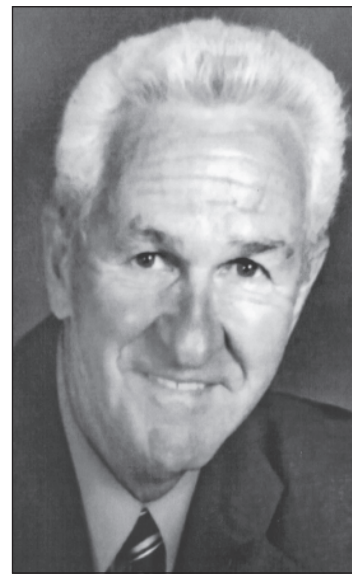
