Lyle was a 1958 graduate of Arcola High School, where he lettered in sports. He also attended Eastern Illinois University and Decatur Barber College.

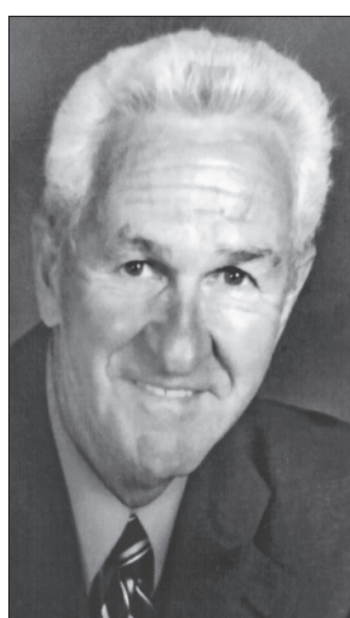
He began his farming career with his brother, Lloyd Johns, and farmed for 40 years.

Wren and Teddy Henry.

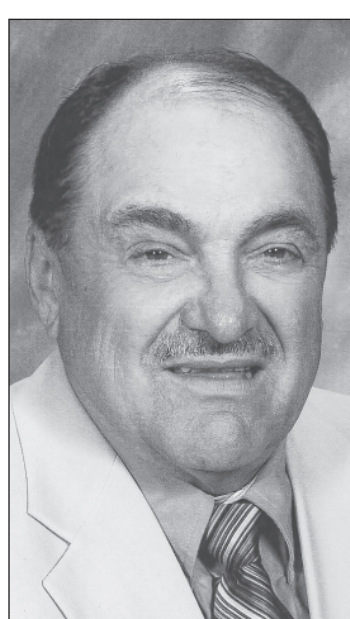

expenses. For 50 percent of the county engineer's salary, the Illinois Department of Transportation transfers \$71,623 of federal service program funds in return for an equal amount of state funds distributed into the motor fuel tax fund.

The Board approved two bridge replacement contracts. The first near Arcola on 1100 E. 550 N., was approved for

\$408,888, which was 4.7 percent below the project estimate, according to Luth.

The second bridge is near Bowdre Township on 100 N. County Rd., a mile and a quarter west of Illinois Route 130. The contract was approved for \$183,702, which is 22.8 percent below the estimate.

The Board approved the purchase of three desks from Das Bauhaus for \$15,150 for the Supervisor of Assessments office. Old furniture will go to

the Douglas County Sheriff's Department.

The Board also received a plaque from the Douglas County Farm Bureau. The current president, Jeff Young, presented the plaque in thanks to the Board's pro-ag resolution in a previous meeting.

"I feel like our organization and your board is very aligned. If there's anything the organization can do to support the board, they will be happy to help," said Young.

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
