Arcola/A-L-A-H girls golf win; boys nip Tuscola, fall to WSS

ARCOLA - The Arcola/Arthur-Lovington-Atwood-Hammond boys' golf team nipped Tuscola for the second time this season, 182-184, but lost to Windsor/Stewardson-Strasburg, who shot a 167 on September 12 at the Kaskaskia Country Club. The next day Arcola was the only team that had enough players for a team score as Tri-County and Decatur Unity Christian competed at the Kaskaskia Country Club. Arcola shot a 174.
