# Feagin seeing some action as true freshman

CHAMPAIGN – Kaden Feagin, a 6-3, 250 pound Freshman running back entered last Saturday's game against Florida Atlantic with five carries for 20 yards. Against the Owls he had his best game with three carries for 28 yards, including a 25-yard run in the final minute in the 23-17 victory as the Fighting Illini improved to 2-2 heading into Big Ten play for

good Saturday at Purdue.

The only game he didn't play in was the season opener, a 30-28 victory over Toledo. Since then he had one carry for five yards in a 34-23 loss to Kansas. In the Big Ten opener against Penn State he had four carries for 15 yards in a 30-13 loss. He is fourth on the team in rushing, which also includes the quarterback.

In high school at Ar-

thur-Lovington-Atwood-Hammond, Feagin earned Illinois High School Football Coaches Association all-state Class 2A honors in 2022 and was the Champaign-Urbana News-Gazette Player of the year. Feagin is from Atwood. He had 147 carries for 1,637 yards last season with 27 touchdowns and completed 45 passes for 695 yards with nine interceptions for the Knights, coached

by Ryan Jefferson. On defense he had 82 tackles, two sacks, two interceptions, three forced fumbles and one touchdown as a safety and linebacker. He was a four-star player from Rivals.com. He suffered a high ankle sprain and an MCL sprain on his right knee early in the Class 2A second round playoff game against Johnston City (a 28-8 loss).

Here is to more playing time for Feagin the rest of the season!

As for the team, who was again, hyped up too much to start the season. I think they are not going to do well in the Big Ten unless the defense can improve as they have given up an average of 245.5 yards per game passing and the Illini just have five more yards than allowed in the passing department. I understand Penn State (276), but allowing 230 to Toledo, 277 to Kansas and 303 against Florida Atlantic. Toledo is 3-1, Kansas is 4-0 as is Penn State and FAU is 1-3. So, yes the first four games were

tough games, but now with the exception of Penn State it all gets tougher.

Also on the other sidelines for Florida Atlantic was former Eastern Illinois university assistant coach Roc Bellantoni is in his second stint for the Owls. He is the defensive coordinator/linebackers coach. He was also at FAU in 2015 and 2016.

At EiU Bellantoni served as an assistant from 2001-11. He was the defensive coordinator from 2002-11 and the associate head coach from 2007-11. Bellantoni helped the Panthers to five Ohio Valley Conference championships (2001, 2002, 2005, 2006 and 2009) and made six NCAA playoff appearances. Bellanoti coached three OVC defenders of the year, including Donald Thoams (2006), Clint Sellers (2005) and Nick Ricks (2002).

Bellantoni also served as an assistant at Auburn, Villanova, Utah State, Washington State, Drake and Buffalo, .
